"Specimens: One envelope, Q12  
One letter, Q13

"No latent impressions of value for identification purposes were developed on the submitted envelope or letter. "

Under date of February 18, 1964, the FBI Laboratory advised the Dallas Office of the FBI as follows:

"Q12 Envelope postmarked 'FORT WORTH TEX. FEB 2, 1964 PM' bearing typewritten and hand printed address 'MRS. Marguerite Oswald Thomas Place Fort Worth, Texas'

"Q13 Slip of paper bearing typewritten message beginning 'SO YOU put...' and ending '...got the President.'

"Result of examination:

"The typewriting on Q12 and Q13 was not identified in the Anonymous Letter File. An appropriate photograph of this typewriting will be added to this file.

"The physical characteristics of the paper comprising Q12 and Q13 have been recorded in the Laboratory for possible future reference. "

On February 11, 1964, WILLIAM L. HUGHES, JR., Assistant United States Attorney, Fort Worth, Texas, advised SA B. TOM CARTER the letter constituted a violation under the Extortion Statute.
