SUBJECT: Investigation of Assassination of President Kennedy

Reference is made to our out Telegram No. 85176 of 26 November 1963 stating that a Moroccan Student named Mohamed Reggab living in West Berlin had stated he knew Marina Oswald in Moscow in early 1961. Reggab further claimed that he had a picture of Marina and a letter from her in his effects in Casablanca, Morocco.

Efforts of this Agency to secure the picture and letters have not been successful. Reggab claimed he wrote to relatives asking them to forward the documents, but they did not arrive.

Information from another source indicated that Reggab had probably been an informant of the Moroccan Intelligence Service while studying in Moscow.

A polygraph examination given to Reggab in West Berlin indicated that he had probably fabricated his claim that he knew Marina Oswald in Moscow and that he had probably not even written to Casablanca to obtain her picture and letter which he claimed to have there.

Reggab has returned to Morocco, promising to send the picture and letter when he finds them.

We have just been advised by _____ that Mr. John H. Hanly, Secret Service Representative assigned to Paris, France, is in West Berlin attempting to contact Reggab. |
Hanly has informed Mr. Hanly of the status of the Reggab case, and Mr. Hanly asked this Agency to advise his headquarters in Washington.
