Former Mrs. Oswald Subpoenaed

NEW CRLEANS (AP) — The widow of Lee Harvey Oswald vas subpoenaed for grand jury tim a today by Dist. tv 'im Garrison, who doubts Warran Commission findings that Cswald alone assassinated Preside t John F. Kennedy. Garrison's office issued the subpoena for Marina Oswald Porter, now of Richardson, λ a Dallas suburb. to appear here Feb. 8-9 as part of Garrison's controversial probe into the assassination. Asst. Dist. Attv. James L. Alcock said investigators want to ask her what she knew about Oswald's activities in New Orleans during the summer of 1963.

Kennedy was killed Nov. 22, 1963, in Dallas, Tex. Oswald was

shot to death during a jail transfer two days later by Jack Ruby, who has since died from cancer...

cancer. Mrs. Porter, who later married Kenneth Jess Porter, lived he e with Oswald during the summer preceding the assassination. It was during this summer, Garrison maintains, that Oswald and others conspired to murd r Kennedy.

Garrison contends the plot led to the murder by a team of anti-Castro guerrilla fighters.
