In this hearty endorsement of Dr. McKnight's congratulation and praise I want to add excellent command of cumbersome and confusing materials and first-rate judgement in the opinions offered.

He may have picked up all the typos and similar slight errors I marked on the copy you gave me. There is one factual error of no real significance, so slight I think you can ignore it for now. It relates to 66-1313, and they played such games with it a single and a slight error is quite good!

I also have a few stylistic suggestions for the future. One I do not want to forget is providing the full name and title, if any, at first mention.

I particularly like the kind of honesty reflected in footnoting SOBIR, in saying you are not absolutely certain of its meaning and then offering what I believe is correct. I've never seen it explained in any FBI record and I've never bothered to ask because I am confident it is what you suggest.

I believe that those with no subject-matter knowledge at all, ranging from your peers to your parents, will find this quite comprehensible and, I think, interesting.

When a student does as well as you have and at the same time turns out something entirely original on this subject, I am more than repaid for the time you took.

You ought feel very good about this fine job you have done. You have earned letting yourself feel that way.
