

Oswald Brother Says Motive Not Given in Report

WICHITA FALLS, Tex. (AP)—Robert Oswald says he agrees with the Warren Commission that his brother, Lee Harvey, acting alone, killed President John F. Kennedy, but asserts that the commission failed to determine why.

He said Americans are entitled to new details and so he is writing a book which he hopes will help explain why.

"One thing that has always bothered me is the why of this thing," he said yesterday.

"That's the reason for the book. I'm putting, as completely as possible, my entire recollection of Lee into it."

He suggested that a committee of some sort be created to look into the so-called "unanswered questions" raised by critics of the commission, but saw no need for a new, full-scale investigation.
