But the fact is that deLosch did make the sgents available to him, as he says in the book, and it would be wrong to assume Bishou is always wrong.

From the Bonner (ugh) I am led to believe there was a Quigley report other than the one finauting in his testimony. This is my conclusion and may not be so.
