JFK Death Probe Has 3 Oswalds

NEW ORLEANS (UPI) — A third man named Oswald entered Dist. Atty. Jim Garrison's investigation of President Kennedy's assassination Thursday.

Julius Oswald of New Orleans was subpoenaed Wednesday to appear before Garrison Thursday.

EARLIER Wednesday, a second Oswald, William Oswald of suburban Metairie, was subpoenaed and spent a half hour in Garrison's office. He did not say whether he had any relationship with Lee Harvey Oswald, the man identified by the Warren Commission as Kennedy's assassin.

Lee Harvey Oswald was born in New Orleans and lived here shortly before he left for Dallas, in September 1963, the Warren report said.

HE HAD one known relative in the New Orleans area, an aunt, Mrs. Hazel Oswald of Metairie.

The report said Lee Harvey Oswald visited Mrs. Hazel Oswald and she gave him a picture of his father. There is no listing for a Mrs. Hazel Oswald in the current telephone directory.
