It is a book about Nosenko, who he regards as a KGB villain sent here to make trouble he allegedly did make. He is looking for JohnDonovan under whom Oswald worked in the Marines. There is to be an assassination chapter.

What he told me about Dohovan was confidential so - do not record it.

Donovan did not know Oswald in Japan but did at Subi Point and at Santa Ana.

He says he can't find any trage of "ohovan now.

He described himself as the Readers Digest editor on Epstein's "Legend" and on Herny Hurt's "Reasonable Douht."

He says he once met Nosenko by accident and later came to believe it was not by accident. That is, it was arranged for them to meet.
