\$1,000 'Bounty' Offered 'For Any Patrolman'

SACRAMENTO, Calif. (UPI) — California highway patrolmen were alerted yesterday to a rumor a chapter of the Hell's Angels had put a \$1,000 bounty on any patrolman to retaliate for the shooting of two of its members.

The Baldwin Park patrol office said the bounty apparently was offered in retaliation for two Hell's Angels shot last week by a patrolman who said they tried to steal his motorcycle. One was killed and the other critically wounded.
