This is a synopsis of events at this Center on this date from approximately 1600 through 2400, prepared on the spot, and to the best of my recollection.

- 1. 222147Z NAVCINTSUPPCEN TWX requested MARCCRPS record check on Oswald. ONI Eiles indicated that Oswald had been separated from the MARCCRPS in 1960.
- DIO 9ND TWX 222223Z stated jacket mailed this P.M. to HQ USMC WASH. D.C. Maj. Vanderswag stated service record not available until at least Monday.
- 3. 1700 Mr. Pascal delivered supplemental file to Intelligence Plot.
- 4. 1900- ONI investigative file received at Center and reviewed by Capt Johnson Capt Jackson and Adm. Taylor informed.
- 5. At appromimately 1930 Captain Johnson placed a call to Special FBI Agent Williams in Dallas, and gave him the gist of a letter from Oswald to Connally who had been SECNAV.
- 6. Meanwhile, ONI duty officer had been informed of a request being prepared from General Carroll of DIA to see the file on Oswald.
- 7. Admiral Taylor and Capt Jackson advised of this request by Captain Johnson at approximately 2000.
- 8. Admiral Taylor's instructions were to prepare a file for him to be passed to General Carroll. This file is to be carried to Admiral Taylor's office by special agent Bliss who will then carry the file to General Carroll who will peruse the file and reture it to the special agent.
- 9. At approximately 2200 I received a call from the Intelligence Duty Officer that I was to release no files to anyone except by his order. However, I received his permission to prepare copies of the files for possible use by Secret Service, FBI, and other possible authorized activities.

9. Copies of Oswald's letter are being transmitted to BBI, and Secret Service on 23 November.







Reformat of your case to this board was premised on reliable information which indicated that you had renounced your United States citizenship with the intentions of becoming a permanent citizen of the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics. 

# U.S. Defector to Reds Turned to Marx at 15

MOSCOW, Nov. 26.—"For
two years now I have been
waiting to do this one thing: waiting to do this one thing:
To dissolve my American citizenship and become a citizen of
the Soviet Union." Today 20year-old Lee Harvey Oswald of
Fort Worth, Tex., is in Moscow.
He hopes he's close to his goal.

· With his suit of charcoal gray fiannel, dark tie and tan cashmere sweater, Lee looks every bit like Joe College. His life hasn't been that of a typical

hasn't been that of a typical college boy, however.

His father, an insurance salesman, died before Lee was born. Reared in Texas and Louislana, the boy spent two years in New York during his searly teens. At 17 he enlisted in the Marines. in the Marines.

"I did it because we poor and I didn't want to be a burden on my mother," he says. Later he spent 14 months as a licensed radar operator in the Far East.

### Vows He Won't Return

In September, his three-year In September, his unfee-year hitch nearly over; Lee was given a dependency discharge from the Marines. The next month he arrived in Moscow to peti-tion the Supreme Soviet, highhe arrived in Moscow to petition the Supreme Soviet, highest legislative body in the USSR, for Soviet citizenship. Living in Moscow's Hotel Metropole on money, he earned as a United States Marine, Lee Cawald, waits-for, an answer. Seen though Russian officials have warned/him. Soviet citizenship is not leasy to obtain. Lee already refers to the Soviet government as my government. But even it I'm not accepted, on no account, will Lee says. I shall remain here, if necessary, as a resident allen. The only thing Soviet officials now on in Russia regardless. Membre in becomes a citizen.

Meanwhile, they're "investigating" the possibility of sending him to a Soviet higher technical instotute.

What brought this serious. soft-spoken southern boy to Moscow? Evidently, it's a combination of poverty, what he considers the plight of United States Negroes, and the United States Marines.

"My mother has been a worker all her life," Lee says. "She's a good example of what happens to workers in the United States." He declines to

elaborate. "At the age of 15," he adds, "after watching the way work-ers are treated in New York, and Negroes in the South I was looking for a key to my

Lee was struck, in particular, by Mark's "Das Kapital." He concluded that, as an American. "I would become either a work exploited for capitalist profit, for an exploiter or, since there are many in this category. I'd be one of the unemployed."

Lee became a Marxist. Later, as a Martine Corps private in Japani and the Philippines, he had a chance to watch American militarist; imperialism in action.

# Asks Soviet Citizenship

MOSCOW, Oct. 3f UPD. Lee Harvey Oswald 20, a re-cently discharged United States Marine from Fort Worth, Tex., disclosed today that he had taken steps for renounce his American citizen-ship and become a Soviet citizen. He said the reasons for his move were "purely politi-

cal."
"I will never return to the

"I will never return to the United States for any reason." Oswald told a reporter in his room at Moscow's Hotel Metropole.

The young Texan declined to give any details on his back ground or the reasons for his decision. But a U. S. Embassy official said Oswald had told him he arrived in Moscow on Oct. 15 immediately after his discharge from the Marine Corps and had no regular Job in the United States.
