As for Mr. Weisberg, he is an eccentric gentleman. In fact, he did not wish to cooperate at the time I was writing my book and certainly I did not send an assistant to see him. I hasten to say that while he is indeed eccentric, he is also a brilliant and dedicated man.

I am sure you will find Gary Shaw and Penn Jones through Paul Hoch whom I now see you in fact mention in your letter. There has indeed been no further statement from the Justice Department. Once again, Hoch is your best source in this area.
