Dear Harold,

Interesting that you hear that I've been involved with someone's book. News is news, I guess, whether of any real significance or not. I helped a journalist-researcher type to get started on a survey of the literature (and thereby the theories). My own approach to the field, a piecemeal, booksellerish approach, appealed to the guy (Bob Callahan) and he adapted it, in a way, to suit a book treatment.

I'm satisfied to trust my inner sense, bolstered with real-life observations, that Kennedy was killed by the real government--so to speak. Guided by the dozen or so books I've read, I am no more a scholar of the subject than I am a "researcher."

It's possible that my credit in the matter of Bob's book will get some pamphlet or publishing info my way. I'll pass it on to you.

Clerking in a used book store(s) gives me a certain finger on the pulse general; and I experience fairly frequent inquiry for treatments of the assassination. Generally what is useful, is what is wanted. Buyers fall to the side of keen interest

and "condition doesn't matter," or to the side of "condition is really important because the subject is important." Regardless, there are no impassive buyers, save that many affect a surface impassivity. Conspiracy in general is a more respectable field..

I'll try to keep you abreast of the developments that develop around me.
