On 11/30/63 Mr. R. H. MYERS, Supervisor, LTV Co. Laboratories, Great Southwest District, Arlington, Texas, telephonically advised that they have approximately 120 engineers and a complete laboratory which they would like to make available to the FBI for any service that they may perform.

MYERS stated that as an example, the pictures of the President's assassination in the current issue of Life Magazine brought to his mind that if they had the film available they could make a complete analysis of the film.

MYERS stated that they could actually determine the time between each shot through analysis of this film.

MYERS was advised that the FBI had their Laboratory in Washington, D. C., and the film he referred to would be handled by the FBI Laboratory.

MYERS was advised that his offer was appreciated, and if any occasion arose where his services could be used he would be notified.
