In obtaining the items requested by CONRAD, no mention is to be made of the fact that the Bureau is working with Atomic Energy Commission with reference to this paraffin cast. As soon as the above items can be obtained, they should be shipped to the attention of the FBI Laboratory.

(4) A sample of the water used in making the washing. If this was regular hydrant water, the Laboratory desires a small bottle of the type water used.

(3) Did the individual who made the paraffin tests save the washings when he actually washed the paraffin casts? If he did, we should try and obtain a sample of the washings.

(2) A small sample of any chemicals that were used in making the paraffin test. CONRAD said a small vial of from 1 cc to 3cc's of each type chemical would be sufficient, and to make certain they were labeled. CONRAD also mentioned that if sulphuric acid had been used, to make certain that this were marked properly, as there were special requirements in shipping acids.

(1) As soon as convenient, samples of the paraffin used. This would refer to unused cakes of paraffin from which the casts were prepared. Assistant Director IVAN W. CONRAD advised that with reference to the examination of the paraffin casts, that were previously submitted by the Dallas Office, the Laboratory has been in touch with the Atomic Energy Commission on certain phases of the examination, and in this connection, the Laboratory desired to have furnished as soon as convenient, samples of the paraffin used. This would refer to unused cakes of paraffin from which the casts were prepared.
