Re memo of ASAC KYLE G. CLARK, 9/21/64, concerning status of Dr. MARTIN F. MASON who conducted parafin tests in instant case.

On 9/21/64 Detective E. ODELL WALKER, Identification Division, Dallas PD, Dallas, Texas, in the absence of Capt. GEORGE M. DOUGHTY, telephonically advised that Dr. MARTIN F. MASON is Director of the Dallas-City County Criminal Investigation Laboratory, Parkland Memorial Hospital, Dallas, and as such makes chemical analysis tests for the Dallas PD and any other local law enforcement agency when requested to do so.

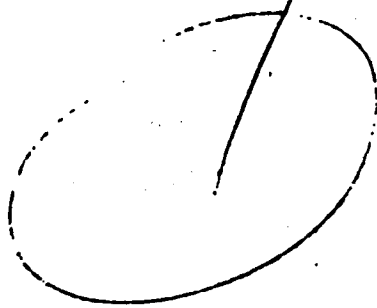
