On 9/21/64 Detective E ODELL WALKER, Identification Division, Dallas PD, Dallas, Texas, in the absence of Capt. GEORGE M, DOUGHTY, telephonically advised that Dr. MARTIN F. MASON is Director of the Dallas-City County Criminal Investigation Laboratory, Parkland Memorial Hospital, Dallas, and as such makes chemical analysis tests for the Dallas PD and any other local law enforcement agency when requested to do so.

Dr. MARTIN is not a member of the Dallas PD but donducted the parafin tests in the OSWALD case as he would have in any other case, upon the request of the Dallas PD.
