Partin, Dunham Plead Innocent On 5 Counts

BATON ROUGE (AP) — Teamster boss Edward Grady Patin and industrialist Ted Dunham Jr., both of Baton Rouge, have pleaded innocent to five counts each of con-spiracy and extortion.

Dunham also entered innocent pleas in federal district court yesterday here for three of his firs named in the June 20 indictment by a fed-eral grand jury in New Or-

leans.

The indictment alleged that the strikes, work stoppages and property damage by Teamster Local No. 5 were used to force builders to buy

Dunham's concrete products. Their trial is expected to begin about Dec. 1 in New

Orleans.
