Nevertheless, Audie Murphy pass the statement on to top White House aides and to Attorney General John Mitchell.

Since the parole hearing, Hoffa's lawyers have been trying to get Partin to make a sworn, signed statement before a lawyer familiar with the jury-tampering case who would be able to weed out inaccuracies.

And Audie Murphy, until his tragic death, was also working to get a more plausible affidavit from Partin although, according to a trusted friend, he was convinced that Partin was lying to get himself off the hook in the case pending against him.
