Taping of a radio broadcast I did by phone last night was delayed long enough for me to skim some of what Policoff sent me and to read the rest. Because I think you might have more and because this is nothing like the 180 pages you mentioned I list it:

My 4/11/78 letter to Jerry

Slip of paper with Richard Ryan's address

Two of Jimmy's letters to Jerry, dates partly eliminated in xeroxing, look like February of this year. One has a list with it or there is a separate list of things Jimmy seems to want.

Affidavits, one each by you, Tina Denaro, Susan Wadsworth, Edwin Day.

Executive session transcript, pp. 134-149, map with it only.

Blakey's 2/24/78 letter to you.

Baetz' note of 2/28/78 to you.

Blakey's 8/10/78 statement about you.

James Wolf's 9/8/78 letter to you with Stokes' statement to the administration committee of the House, 14 pp.

If there is more please send it, I'll copy and return.

I'll be surprised if you have no more than this.

The statement says that the FBI tipped you off that Jerry knew about you. Can you tell me any more about this so I can check the completeness of the records the FBI will be giving me?

What was Baetz' reaction when he read my letter and learned I do not think Lane is with it?

I would expect Baetz to have had some interest in the list Jerry had from Jimmy. What interested Jimmy should have interested the committee. Jerry has not indicated that he was asked about this at all. Were you? Of course if this executive session was the only one, that means by Baetz of Waxman, I guess.

If you are ever around this way I think it would be good if we taped what is known as an oral history. I have no special interest in this stuff for my writing but I do have interest in making a good historical record. The tape you sent me, where you record your personal recollections, is much better but it is incomplete. I think if we were to talk about it you'd recall more.

While I have no interest in Baetz wanting to be fixed up, which is not without precedent when he saw your porno videotapes, I do have interest in what interested him and the committee through him. Nothing so far reflects any interest in fact of the crime itself. Goes for Waxman, too.

This also has nothing on your taping, except mention of it. It does not say how the FBI turned you over to the committee, which they claim they never do. Or Geppert, who I probably met and would not recall. Jerry, Stoner, others and I did a St. Louis TV show about April 1972 and Stoner had a gang around him.

If you can think of anything else and have time, thanks for it.
