Dear Jerry:

I'll just write you in reference to Judge Brown's dismissal of the libel suit against McMillian. This was an unusual and probably illegal ruling since he had done ruled on the same thing onced before. What I think we should do is for you to write the court a letter asking them to preserved all the records for the select committee. This is because you made a sworn statenments in the suit that you knew nothing of the King case and, when you took the matter to the courts they would do nothing about the libel or ineffect go into the matter. What I will do if write Judge Brown with duplicate copies to the J.D. congress, the chief Justice (Burger) citing among other think what Murphy said on the tape. I'll say that neither I or anyone related to me have any standing in Memphis court. therefore I won't file further petition in Memphis regardless of whether the law say I have to because of venue.

If you don't get the complete \$250.00 back then I'll sue Judge Brown & the clerk for it. Since I gave it to you it is legally mane. I'll proably have to tell the court about the money I made in Nashville and gave to you while I was in that prison but that won't mean anything as what I did there dosen't mean anything now anyway.
