6. In 1970-71 y drove to Miami to check Miami telephone directory fro Rosen name, didn't find any Rosen under Randolph Erwin name.
7. Call Hoffa son about Parton (what date about ? (I ask you to do most of these things.
8. Talk to Judge Schoolfield about Hoffa & Parton
9. When they try send me nut house in 1973 you contact Finley of Daily News and Clyde Watts. Watts about nut house and Finley about Rosen connection in N.O.
10. About this time you also wrote Congressman from Missouri under Albert's name about Rosen and progressive labor party, Congres man sent you some books.
11. I had you ask Watts about Rosen and his possible criminal record in N.O. (Watts checked and said named most likely Randolph Erwin ROSENSON, And gave you info about Rosenson arrest record in New Orleans federal court.
12. You made trip to New Orleans to check on Rosenson but found nothing.
13. You went to Miami and checked on ROSENSON name and found it under RANDY and gave it to me.
