An FBI memorandum dated 8/3/78, that I have already mailed to you shows that the House Select Committee on Assassinations was in fact the source of information concerning my testimony before the H.S.C.A. was responsible for the perjury charges levied against John Ray by the H.S.C.A.

In the letter to you from G. Robert Blakey dated 3/9/79, Blakey states that my "testimony before the Committee was not responsible for the recommendation by the Committee to the Department of Justice that Mr. John Ray be investigated for perjury before the committee".
