During my association with both the F.B.I. and House Select Committee on Assassinations I was involved in and saw certain investigative techniques employed by these agencies which I believe to be of questionable nature.

I question both the legality and ethics of some of these practices.

I am bringing this matter to your attention because I have hopes that you will recognize the gross improprieties involved by these investigative agencies.

Enclosed is a copy of a statement I have written which details these techniques used by these agencies.

I have also written a letter similar to this one to F.B.I. Director William Webster.
