Dear Mr. Pearson:

Frankly, I was very surprised when reading your column yesterday to see that you chose to revive your criticism of the FBI which was published on December 14, 1963.

It is completely false to state or even imply that we ever made any attempt to cover up our actions in the Oswald investigation. At no time did any representative of the FBI ask any friend of Oswald to conceal from the press that we had talked to him about Oswald. We have openly testified before the Presidential Commission concerning our complete activities. A review of the Commission's report would make this clear.
