

Trials of Pelley Aides Put Over to November

PITTSBURGH, May 26.—Trials of five persons charged with harboring a fugitive indicted on a sedition charge have been continued to the November term of court, United States Attorney Charles F. Uhl said. They had been scheduled to open today.

Mr. Uhl said a motion had been made attacking the indictments, necessitating delay in starting the trials.

The five are Adelaide Marion Pelley of Noblesville, Ind., daughter of William Dudley Pelley, convicted Silver Shirt leader; Marguerite Marie Carmichael of Noblesville, formerly secretary to Pelley; Victor Warren Hoye of New Castle, Pa.; Frank W. Mariner of Poland, Ohio, and Henry Herman Meine of New Galilee, Pa.
