I received your letter of June 20, 1978, I will tell you just a little bit of my knowledge of the case of the assassination of the President of the United States John F. Kennedy.

I knew and I worked with as an informer F.B.I. agent Warren C. DeBreeys. And I knew Mr. Oswald very well too and I can prove it. When Oswald was transferred to Dallas I saw Mr. Warren C. DeBreeys was transferred to Dallas, Texas too by the F.B.I. The Federal Agents used Dallas Texas because of the big amount of Europeans including Russians in Dallas. It was easy for them to confuse the American population by doing the killing in Dallas. When you come to New Orleans I will prove to you that I took pilot lessons from Dave William Furi.

You asked me the where abouts of Mr. Warren C. DeBreeys, the last I heard from him not to long ago he is that he is working with the crime commission in the city of

New Orleans.

If you come to New Orleans as you said you will, I will brief you much more about all of this matter.
