A review of FD-302's reflects that JESSE R. CORE, III was interviewed by SA JAMES ROYCE ~~PK~~, 11/29/63, concerning handbills handed out in front of the International Trade Mart, 8/16/63. CORE stated he observed this activity for some 20 to 25 minutes and saw two people handing out handbills.

CORE should be recontacted with photos of this activity to determine if the two persons observed by him were OSWALD and CHARLES HALL STEELE and whether or not he observed a third person handing out handbills. It is noted that STEELE and OSWALD are the only ~~ones~~ who can be definitely determined from photos as handing out the handbills but STEELE has stated when he met OSWALD in front of the International Trade Mart Building he was accompanied by another individual described as having olive complexion, dark hair and approximately 6 feet tall, who apparently was handing out some handbills.
