1. Dr. FERNANDO PENABAZ, Editor, "Today's World," 4017 Aurora Street, was interviewed at that address. He furnished the following information:

PENABAZ recalls an interview he participated in which was taped by a television station in Orlando, Florida, concerning the assassination of President KENNEDY. During the interview he mentioned that an individual by the name of JACK RUBENSTEIN was a member of the Marxist Youth League in either 1930 or 1936. This individual was about 22 years old at the time, generally in the age group of the individual currently held in Dallas, Texas. He does not have any information to indicate that both JACK RUBENSTEINS are the same person or that both RUBENSTEIN and OSWALD were conspirators in the assassination of President KENNEDY.

PENABAZ stated that the information indicating that one JACK RUBENSTEIN was a member of the Marxist Youth League was obtained from records of the Dies Committee hearings which he had reviewed. He explained that he has been doing a considerable amount of research on Communism for about 20 years and is very disturbed about the Communist influence throughout the world.
