JOSÉ SORIA PEREZ, 5204 Junius, Apartment 8, Dallas, Texas, after being advised that he did not have to make a statement, that any statement made could be used against him in a court of law, and that he had the right to consult an attorney, furnished the following information:

PEREZ is employed as an electronic assembler, Power Engineering Company, Richardson, Texas, and has been so employed since April 23, 1963. He came to Dallas in April, 1963, from Rio Hondo, Texas. He formerly served in the U. S. Air Force from April, 1955, to October, 1962, under serial number 18479958, receiving an honorable discharge.

PEREZ is acquainted with ESTHER ALVAREZ and her sister BELTRIZ ALVAREZ, having met them at Our Lady of Guadalupe Church, Harwood Street, Dallas. PEREZ said during the past few weeks, Miss ALVAREZ has been unfriendly toward him and in fact has not even spoken to him for some reason which is unknown to PEREZ. PEREZ stated as far as he knew, he had not done anything to incur the enmity toward him and was at a loss to understand her present attitude toward him. He stated in the past he has been present on social occasions when Miss ALVAREZ and Mrs. SEGURA were members of the group. He stated there was some discussion of the assassination of President KENNEDY which took place among the members of the group after the assassination occurred, however, all discussions were based on news received from the radio, television and the newspapers concerning this event. PEREZ advised he has no knowledge of the assassination of President KENNEDY except what he has heard through the news media. He is not a member of any group in Dallas other than Our Lady of Guadalupe Church. He does not own a pistol or any other type of gun and has never possessed a gun since residing in Dallas, Texas. He stated he was not acquainted with and had never seen LEE HARVEY OSWALD and did not attend any dinner or meeting at which OSWALD was present. PEREZ denied making any statement to anyone that he had been given a dangerous assignment and that his assignment had later been given to another person. He
