Also, Shirley always lived in chans, never could find enything. She had an enormous stack of stuff in her garage. She had great difficulty finding clip ings for me, and I never got one that had been cut from the paper, just born out and, it

She once had a tape of her interview with Father miber. She couldn't find it when I asked her for it. She thought she loaned it to hark. It is possible her correspondence contains contemporaneous comment on what she had been told by those she then (almost immediately) interviewed.
