SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT  
JOHN F. KENNEDY, 11/22/63,  
DALLAS, TEXAS

At approximately 1:05 p.m., SA EMORY HAUGHTON of the Dallas Office called.

HAUGHTON advised that STUART L. REED, St. Charles Hotel, New Orleans, leaving 4 p.m. on unknown boat for Panama Canal Zone, has some 35 mm film being developed by a company in Dallas and one of the slides depicts the building from which the shots were fired, the building being the Texas School Book Depository.

Interview REED to determine when particular shot was made, if it was made before, at or after the assassination and get unrestricted authority to use that slide to make a blow up.

Film is in possession of the Dynacolor Co., Dallas, being processed and will be mailed to his daughter in Dallas.
