The following investigation was conducted by BA MALON L. JENNINGS, SA B. TOM CARTER, and SA ROBLEY D. MADLAND:

AT PORT WORTH, TEXAS

On 11/23/63, JAMES A. BYNON, News Director, WBAP-TV, made available for review TV movie film shot by his employees and NBC photographers on or about the time of the KENNEDY assassination in Dallas, Texas, on 11/22/63.

A review of the film did not disclose any pictures of the building where President KENNEDY was allegedly shot from until this particular act had been a committed. After President KENNEDY was shot, the film committed. After President EKNRKUI was suct, the stand did contain several frames of the building which are regard to people running from the building or people possibly seen in the building as alleged by persons wiewing this file on tolerance at this time. With wiewing this film on television when first shown by MBC, Mr. BYRCN pointed out that this film was first run without being edited and, of course, the sequence might indicate to viewers that the building scene was taken at the time of the assassination, which is not true.

Mr. BYRON advised that NBC photographers' film and the station's own photographers' films were run together as one since this is an NBC station. He pointed out that the NBC photographer shooting film
shortly after the shooting of the President was DAVE WELGHAN. WEIGHAN was riding in a car approximately five cars back of the President. He apparently heard the shooting, jumped out of his car, and with his
