## JFK ASSASSINATION PHOTOGRAPHIC RESEARCH BOOK

This is not a "picture book" but rather a comprehensive research tool covering the photographic material relating to the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. Highlighted topics include:

- o Background information on each photographer including camera type, film type, and location during the assassination.
- o The reports generated by the National Photographic Interpretation Center (NPIC) pertaining to the assassination.
- o The ITEK Corporation analysis of the various films and photographs taken during the assassination.
- o The FBI photographic report on the three tramps.
- o Duplication and purchasing information of photographic exhibits from government, public, and private research centers.
- o A scaled spatial chart of Dealey Plaza (30" x 40"), including the location of the photographers before, during, and after the assassination.
- o Articles on the photographic evidence by assassination researchers Mark Crouch, Robert Cutler, Stephen Peterson, Richard E. Sprague, and John R. Woods II.
