Dear Jim Good,

This will acknowledge receipt of both manuscripts. I appreciate your not holding them longer than necessary.

If at any time you get an interest in the National States' Rights Party, you know where the material is. There is now more. J.E. Stoner has seen Ray, in jail, and may become - in fact, by now may be - his attorney. Frankly, I had hoped you'd go for that part.

One other thing I now have that perhaps some time will interest you as a simple picture thing that with anything else would blow it up. You may recall the police said Oswald claimed one of the two famous pictures of him ~~holding a rifle was a fake~~ and in court he would so prove. Although the detectives conducting the search made receipts for both prints and both negatives, the Commission was lied to when it was told there was only one negative.

"But don't worry", the FBI said, "We've made you a fresh negative from the print!".

I now have a copy of the picture before a lot of work was done on it. There is another person, clearly visible, airbrushed out of the official copies. I have also had both pictures enlarged until the heads are the same size. When the heads coincide, and they do as though there is a single one pasted on two bodies, there is a six-inch difference in the heights.

Even for Oswald, quite an accomplishment.




