Dear Jerry,

I have Metroliner reservations. I'll get to NY Sunday at 11:30, and I'll leave Wednesday at 5:00. I have a call in for Walter, who was not in the office.

I'll enclose a copy of what David called a "release", which I just got today, and my reply. No wonder he got no interest. I'm working on other things I'll tell you about, by phone. That is, I'm working on them by phone. I'll tell you when I'm there. Maybe by then something will have happened. If it does, you'll know.

I've saved the Washington Post coverage of the demonstrations for you. I'll bring them. There was more and better TV coverage than I knew. WTOP-TV covered heavily but not steadily beginning about 11 a.m. I think the NET station covered solidly for six hours.

After seeing the CBS a.m. TV news this morning, we wondered if you were caught in that Turnpike "demonstration".

Just heard from Walter's secretary. He is at a conference and will call tonight.

One of the advantages of going up Sunday is that I can start working Monday morning on some of the things of which you know, without interfering with any appearances. Do not forget that I have to broadcast Monday night, by phone, and have to be free a little before 11 p.m.

If and when you talk to Franklin about his TV show, I'll have pictures I took at the scene of the crime that will not involve paying the media for their use.
