Playboy Board Changes

CHICAGO — Two businessmen who served on Playboy Enterprises, Inc.'s board of directors resigned Friday in the wake of a criminal investigation into alleged use of drugs in Chicago's Playboy mansion.

Robert J. Adelman, chairman of Anthur Rubloff & Co., a Chicago-based real estate company, and Philip Erard, a partner in Leob Rhodes & Co., an investment firm with headquarters in New York, announced their resignations from the eight-member board because of the recent publicity given the investigation and publisher Hugh Hef-

Hefner has been subpoenaed to appear before a Cook County grand jury which is investigating the drug over-dose death of former Palyboy bunny Adrienne Pollack, 23. He is also under investigation by federal authorities on the alleged use of drugs inside the Chicago mansion.
