## Playboy Board Changes

CHICAGO — Two businessmen who served on Playboy Enterprises, Inc.'s board of directors resigned Friday in the wake of a criminal investigation into alleged use of drugs in Chicago's Playboy mansion.

Robert J. Adelman, chairman of Arthur Rubloff & Co., a Chicago-based real estate company, and Philip Erard, a partner in Leob Rhodes & Co., an investment firm with headquarters in New York, announced their resignations from the eight-member board because of the recent publicity given the investigation and publisher Hugh Hefner.

Hefner has been subpoenaed to appear before a Cook County grand jury which is investigating the drug overdose death of former Playboy bunny Adrienne Pollack, 23. He is also under investigation by federal authorities on the alleged use of drugs inside the Chicago mansion.
