Thank you for your letter. I am sorry not to have answered sooner but I have been busy promoting ratification of the Nuclear Non-proliferation Treaty.

It is good that the trial of Clay Shaw is proceeding. Naturally, it is vital that every assistance be given the Garrison office. The public is entitled to have the opportunity to judge all the evidence.

As you must know, Bud Fensterwald has brought suit to obtain the autopsy material from the Archives for the use of Mr. Garrison. It is to be hoped he is successful.

I was interested in your report that anti-Semites, possibly Birchites, were involved in the "Kennedy conspiracy". The Institute for American Democracy, 1330 Massachusetts Ave., N.W., Washington D.C. is devoted to exposing the activities of the radical right. I suggest you send them samples of your material.

If I can be of help in making this material available for use at the trial, please let me know and send me examples of the evidence.
