Posner's representation of his book waried with what he wanted and of whom he wanted it. So did his description of his book.

Although I had the largest collection of formerly withhe; d government records, the largest collection of JFK assassination records outside of government files, he had no real interest in them or the means by which I got them and he did not once ask me to explain to him what each of those many files is, holds, represents or any special signifiance I had found in any one of them. He told me only that he intended for his book to expose the commercialization and exploitation of the assassination.

knew and knew had; and he had a copy of it, He kndw, although he lied about it, that I had written a book on Oswald/yet

I do not recall a simgle question he asked me about Oswald or about his career in New
Orleans, the subject of that book.

Yet a month before he came to work in my files he wrote Edgar Tatro, who has been researchin the assassination and writing about it for more than two decades, "Turrently, I am under contract to Random House for a book evaluating the most recent developments in the assassination of President Kennedy." That is not the book he described to me the next month, obviously. He then asked Tatro for whatever information he had developed or obtained relating to Oswald's having studied Russian and the Monterey Language Scool, as the Commission's general Counsel, J. Lee Rankin had said.

That was while Oswald was in the Marines.

Posner did not even ask me how to see if there was any FBI reference to that in the Dallas FBI special index I have.

And with this expressed interest, he had no interest in my Oswald in New Orleans?

It was the only book on Oswald. It goes into his career in the Parines, when he learned Russian. And he lied about having or using it and omits if from his bibliography when in fact it was the only one of my books he had when he purchased all the others from me.

With his book to "val evaluate" what he described as "the most recent developments in the assassination" and as of that time the only "recent developments" being all those recently government records I had obtained and worthless books pretending to be on the

He had so little interest in what that quarter of a million pages hold he planned only a three-day visit here and, if he had not know the nature and extent of the records I have and make freely available, he knew when he was her. He neither extended his stay nad work nor returned to plumb those files.

His record and his statement to Tatro refute each other. Both cannot be true.

And only from ignorance could be dscribed knowledge that Rankin had said Oswald got his Russian-lamguage knowledge from that Monterey school. It has been known since I got and made available to all the formerly Top Secret" Commission executive sessions.
