\* 1<sup>st</sup> conversation - LHO inquiring how to get into Soviet Embassy - "anyone who speaks English" "No" "call back later - Did he identify

[2<sup>nd</sup> conversation was much longer]

himself? No - just wanted to talk to someone

CIA asked Tarasoff to try to identify caller -

\* 2<sup>nd</sup> long conversation - Singled out as important -

also in English - Mrs. Tarasoff worked on it -

urgent - Speaker gave his name - no comments

about "poor Russian." No editorial comments -

Person did not want to stay in Mexico or

return to US - Wanted financial aid to

get out of Mexico - Went to Lubans + Russian

for financial aid - He said he was broke -

Said nothing about QPQ by giving info.

"cool individual" "determined" - "angry"
