Home address was shown as 657 French St., New Orleans, but there is no such number on that street. The application listed other persons to receive mail in that box as: A. J. Ridell and Marina Osvald.

Under date of September 24, 1963, Form 3575 was mailed to the post office requesting that mail be forwarded to 2515 West 5th Street, Irving, Texas.

Box was closed September 26, 1963.

Two copies of a newspaper called the MILITANT were found on hand tonight. The

LET H. OSMALD rented a furnished spartment at 4905 Magazine, New Orleans, but his mail came addressed 4907 Magazine St. This was an error apparently as 4907 is the front spartment and 4905 is the side spartment at this address.

The carrier for the address stated he had never seen anyone in the partment bit remembered handling mail and says it was nortly foreign newspapers.

Carrier said he received an order to forward all mail to the box.

JESE VARIER, Apertment 4911, is the manager of these spartments and collects the rest. He says that Oswald was home most of the time and did not appear to have a job. He stated Mrs. Oswald was a foreigner and could not speak English.

Hrs. Oswald became pregnant and another woman driving a station vagon with Texas license plates picked her up to drive her to Dallas. She never came back and her husband left a short time later.

The woman driving the station vegon may have been Mrs. Payne but no one in New Orleans interviewed was familiar with the name PAYNE or MICHAEL PAYNE.

The police have no local record on NICHAEL R. PAYME.

LEE H. OSHALD was arrested in Now Orleans on August 9, 1963 in the 700 block of Canal St., charged with Disturbing the Peace, fined\$10 or 10 days.

He entiated in U. S. Marines in 1956.

The information was given FBI agent SYLVESTER. (This refers to the information concerning Police record, etc. The information concerning address, etc., which was disclosed by Inspector Zerza's investigation had not been commitmented to the FBI as the Inspector had not been in touch with them.)
