Dear Mr. Hoover:

A number of statements have been attributed to you recently, concerning the Warren Commission and the assassination of President Kennedy. I wondered if you have a public statement as to your opinions on the validity of the Warren Commission's finding in the conclusion that Lee Harvey Oswald was alone in his carrying out of the assassination of the President.

On many occasions your statements to the public are edited, and it is extremely difficult to ascertain what actually has been said. One small paragraph in quotation marks is included in a long article made up primarily of editorializing and the opinions of the writer as to exactly what you meant. In this case, I feel that the opinion that you express will be of utmost importance as far as the public is concerned.

I am not just requesting this as a matter of personal curiosity. I have the unique opportunity of utilizing the radio on the West Coast, addressing between 150,000 and 200,000 people, quite frequently, in the evenings. I always try to check my facts ahead of time, to make certain that they are correct, and would certainly appreciate your help in clarifying the statements that have been attributed to you.

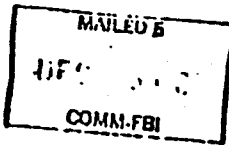
Dear Dr. Monteith:

Director's statements concerning the Warren Commission's findings.

NOTE: Bufiles disclose four prior communications from Dr. Monteith, all of which touched on the question of communist influence in racial matters. He is known to have been a principal speaker at a John Birch Society gathering in Montana and was described as a member of the Minutemen organization in April, 1964. Since that time no acknowledgements have been made to his letters, the last of which was received 9-13-66. In view of the fact it may be in the Bureau's best interest for Dr. Monteith to have available/uncited text of the Director's statements regarding the Warren Commission's findings, it is believed this is an appropriate in this instance.
