This is to advise that on 3/19/64, Mr. C. J. PRICE, Administrator, Parkland Memorial Hospital, Dallas, Texas, advised .... his telephone number is ME'1-5050. He stated a letter had been received by the hospital addressed to "Custodian of Records" from : the Commission which is investigating the assassination of President JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY. This letter was signed by Mr. RANKIN and three similar letters were addressed to "Operating " . Room Personnel" not further identified. Mr. PRICE stated these letters advised that ALEN SPECTER would arrive in Dallas on 3/20/64 and the letters contained attachments explaining the purpose of the investigating committee and copies of the laws\_\_\_\_\_ that they were operating under. He said he had furnished copies of all reports and other information in the hospital records to the FBI, Secret Service, and CIA, and he felt that since he was not personally bonded that he would require the Commission to obtain any additional records by means of subpoena duces tecum. : برچو<del>ر د</del>
