I would have like to have made a special release for PW, but with every-  
thing to do myself, it just has not been possible. Here is a copy of the  
newspaper release.

The first printing is 10,000. I am again the publisher. I wrote the  
present distributors and within 48 hours had phoned-in orders for 25% of this  
printing. Some bookstores are already advertising it. Paul Elder, in San  
Francisco (where I sign copies 12/15) sponsored a two-hour broadcast on which  
I spoke by phone from my home.

I expect those distributing WHITEWASH: THE REPORT ON THE WARREN REPORT  
to distribute the sequel, WHITEWASH II: THE FBI-SECRET SERVICE COVERUP. This  
is an entirely new book, coming mostly from the hitherto secret files of the  
Warren Commission, <sup>with</sup> which it is illustrated (11 line cuts, 13 photographs).
