Your interesting memos of 12/17 and 21(2) arrived today.

I missed the point you so properly raise in asking about FBI knowledge of Oswald's use of the 544 Camp St. address. Certainly just about everyone in the N.O. FBI office knew or knew of Benister and his connections. It is likely most knew of the CRC, etc. Without doubt, Quigley did notice the address. It is only part of what he knew he was omitting.

The FBI was also unhelpful to the Commission on occasion, to the extent that the lawyers caught on. I shall eventually publish this.

If someone else wants CD 1287 restricted, please let me know. Also, its contents, if it is sent you.

Liebeler has agreed to a March debate. Anything that develops on the Ex237 thing could be very interesting.

Somewhere, unofficially, I've heard that Quigley is no longer with the FBI. This may be entirely wrong, or my recollections may be in error, but the notion lingers in my mind. It is my own hunch that Oswald did not expect Quigley to answer his call.
