Tuesday, November 26, 1996, was an important day at The Long Island College Hospital...

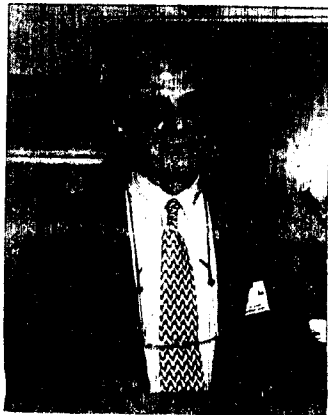
