Sometime in about September, 1951, FRANK CHAVEZ told PAMOS DUCOS that CHAVEZ had an appointment to meet RICHAND KAVNER, International Vice President of Teamsters Union, and JACK RUBY as well as a third Teamsters official whose name RAMOS DUCOS could not recall.
