(Our ties with them were always very slight - due mainly to their inability or lack of interest in helping local groups - like they say if you want something done you have to do it yourself.)

Well, what do you think of the Congressional investigation? (circus!) I see Lane is up to his old tricks! How does he get away with it? Unfortunately, he's helping to damage what little credibility is left. If Congress fails - which you cautioned us on all along, what is our next move?
