Source advised there appeared to be a check inside the registered letter. [redacted] is described as a white male, age 43, 6'3" tall, 170 pounds. Bureau indices, Newark indices and Atlantic City Police Department files negative on [redacted]. Credit Bureau, Atlantic City indicates [redacted] served in U. S. Army in 1945. His occupation is listed as a bartender.
