U.S. BUREAU OF PRISONS. INFORMATION SUBMITTED IN PREVIOUS MEMPHIS TELETYPE RE CONTACT WITH

THIS DATE ADVISED SIS WITH BUREAU OF PRISONS AND HAS BEEN ASSIGNED AT FEDERAL PRISON, MARION, ILLINOIS. VILL BE ACTING IN LIAISON CAPACITY AND FURNISHING ASSISTANCE TO SHELBY COUNTY, TENN., SO WHO WILL BEAR RESPONSIBILITY OF SUBJECT RAY IN INSTANT CASE.

ADVISED HE HAD HAD MEETINGS WITH REPRESENTATIVES OF SO, STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL CANALE, AND INTERESTED LOCAL JUDGES IN CONNECTION WITH HANDLING OF PRISONER. SAID HE HAD SUBMITTED VARIOUS RECOMMENDATIONS BASED ON STANDARDS OF BUREAU OF PRISONS IN . HANDLING PRISONERS OF PROMINENCE. HE INDICATED AMONG ITEMS DISCUSSED WERE THE HANDLING OF VOCUMEROFOLMAIL THAT PRISONER OF PROMINENCE WOULD PROBABLY RECEIVE, RESTRICTIONS OF VISITORS TO PRISONER, AND OTHER MISCELLANEOUS PROBLEMS LANGUES TYPE. 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HE STATED HE HAD MADE CERTAIN SUGGESTIONS FOR IMPROVING SECURITY AT THE SHELBY COUNTY.

ADVISED THAT THE MATTERS WHICH HE HAD SUBMITTED IN
THE FORM OF SUGGESTIONS TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES HAD BEEN DISCUSSED
BY HIM WITH AAG FRED VINSON IN WASHINGTON, D.C. DURING COURSE OF
CONVERSATION, STATED AAG VINSON HAD TOLD HIM THAT IT
APPEARED THAT THE EARLIEST ANY POSSIBLE ACTION MIGHT BE TAKEN
INSOFAR AS EXTRADITION OF RAY FROM ENGLAND WOULD BE ON OR ABOUT JULY
THIRTEEN, NEXT. STATED HE THOUGHT AAG VINSON MIGHT BE
OPTIMISTIC IN REGARD TO THIS DATE.

COUNTY SO INDICATED THAT IT MIGHT BE ADVISABLE FOR ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL-TYPE INVESTIGATIONS TO BE CONDUCTED RE DUPUTIES WHO MIGHT BE ENTRUSTED TO CARE AND PROTECTION OF PRISONER RAY. HE MADE TENTATIVE INQUIRY AS TO POSSIBILITY OF FBI CONDUCTING SPECIAL INVESTIGATIONS OF THIS TYPE. AS TOLD BY SAC THAT INVESTIGATIONS OF THIS TYPE WERE NOT CONDUCTED BY FBI. IT WAS SUGGESTED TO THAT SINCE PRIME RESPONSIBILITY FOR PROTECTION OF THIS PRISONER RESTED WITH SO AND THAT THE STATE AG WOULD ALSO HAVE GREAT INTEREST IN CUSTODY OF PRISONER, CONSIDERATION MIGHT BE END PAGE TWO

GIVEN TO HAVE STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S OFFICE CONDUCT PERTINENT PERSONNEL INVESTIGATIONS FOR SO.

IN THIS CONNECTION, IT MIGHT BE NOTED THERE ARE TWO
NATIONAL ACADEMY GRADUATES ASSIGNED TO STATE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S
OFFICE,

JOHN LEWIS CARLISLE AND EDUNA L. HUTCHINGSON, JR.,

CLARK ALSO STATED THAT IN HIS DISCUSSION WITH AAG VINSON,
VINSON TOLD HIM THAT HE HAD SEEN THE SUBJECT IN THE CELL IN THE
BRITISH PRISON WHERE HE IS HELD. THE CELL WAS DESCRIBED AS
BEING VERY BLEAK AND THE BED CONSISTED OF BEDDING STRETCHED OVER
A BOARD WHICH SERVED AS THE BED IN THIS PARTICULAR CELL. ON SMALL
SPIGOT WITH A RECEPTACLE SURROUNDING IT SAFISFIED THE PRISONER
FROM THE STANDPOINT OF DRINKING WATER AND HIS USE IN CONNECTION
WITH BODILY FUNCTIONS.

STATED THAT AAG VINSON ALSO TOLD
HIM THERE WERE TWO CONSTABLES IN THE CELL WITH RAY AT ALL TIMES.

HE ALSO SAID THAT UNDER BRITISH LAW, REPORTEDLY A PRISONER MUST HAVE TWO HOURS OF EXERCISE ON A DAILY BASIS. DURING THE EXERCISE PERIOD OF RAY, WAS TOLD THE EXERCISE YARD IS CLEARED OF ALL PERSONNEL AND THE BRITISH AUTHORITIES DO HAVE SECURITY DOGS ON HAND IN THE EVENT OF ANY PROBLEMS ARISING.

NO OTHER PERTINENT ACTIVITY THIS DATE.
